2018 Wild Horse Race Ground Rules

WILD HORSE RACE

Purse \$8,500.00 added. **Entry fee per team, \$500.00 (cash, money order or credit card). Entry fees are due in full Day of Entry's** Entries will be limited to 36 teams, 9 teams per day (team days are consecutive). All competitors must be at least 19 years of age. Unless extended by the Committee, entries will close at the beginning of the first performance. Each team will receive the same number of horses during the first eight days of the rodeo. Race will be two (2) head and a final. Top 11 teams will advance to finals. If there are any ties, all teams will be drawn.

ENTRY RULES: The Committee will determine the maximum number of teams for entry. Each contestant upon entry will present valid identification and social security number. **TEAMS SHALL CONSIST OF THREE (3) MEMBERS.** (Substitutes will be allowed no matter if he/she has competed with another team.)

PRCA rules for humane treatment of animals will apply. Absolutely no hot shots allowed. Any use of hot shots will result in disqualification for the entire rodeo and will be subject to a \$250.00 fine.

TRACK RULES:

- 1) **Teams may not move the horses in anticipation of the direction they think the race is going.**
- 2) Contestants may not mug or make contact with the horse until the gun sounds. This is for the benefit of the contestant who received his horse last and to make the race equal to all entries. No one may touch their horse prior to the start of the race.
- 3) **No choking down, no blocking of airways, no deliberate tripping, no half hitches around the horse's neck by halter shank or rope, and no mugger may take hold of the horse's eyes or mouth in any manner. No biting or grabbing horse's ears. No gouging of the eyes or grabbing of the nose.**
- 4) Once a contestant has accepted his stock from the lead man, it is his stock and no re-rides will be given unless directed by the discretion of the judges. Horses to be saddled while standing up only.
- 5) **Cheyenne Frontier Days reserves the right to order any contestant to release the animal for the safety of the animal. At the discretion of Cheyenne Frontier Days, dependent upon the circumstances, contestant may or may not be offered a re-ride. You will be ordered to turn horse loose for any mistreatment or unnecessary roughness (refer to Rule 4). Team will be immediately disqualified for the remainder of the 2018 Cheyenne Frontier Days and will be subject to a \$500.00 fine.**
- 6) Once mounted and moving around the track, the contestant will not receive assistance from any other person, including muggers. Ground crew: once rider is mounted and headed in the right direction, you must clear the track. You must stay off track after rider is gone.
- 7) **Riders: NO abuse of the horse in any manner. NO foreign objects will be allowed, bats, rattles, plastic bags, etc., to coax the horse. Riders may have spurs but they must not have locked or sharpened rowels. (Rowels must move freely, no bull shanks.) Riders: if you are caught spurring your horse in the neck or head, your team will be disqualified for the entire Cheyenne event and you will be subject to a \$500.00 fine.**

- 8) There will be a time limit of five (5) minutes, or all places have crossed the finish line for the race. After two (2) minutes, any horse and contestant not mounted and proceeding on the track will be removed away from the gate by the pick-up men assigned to assist the WHR.
- 9) **Contestants must be in the saddle on the horse. Riders: after you finish, dismount safely ASAP in the arena.**
- 10) In case of a tie for overall first place, a flip of the coin will determine the recipient of the buckles. If a tie exists between more than two teams, buckle winners will be determined by a draw from a hat.
- 11) **Judges' decisions will be FINAL.**
- 12) **PRCA dress code will be enforced.**
- 13) No companions or people without a contestant's number will be allowed in the Wild Horse Race ready area.
- 14) **Any team members entering the arena in a state of drunkenness or under the influence of drugs or alcohol shall have his team disqualified at the discretion of the judges. No alcohol is allowed in the Wild Horse Race ready area. Violations of any of the above rules will result in disqualification and the judges' decisions will be final.**
- 15) **If you are not up and want to watch the race: Teams will only be allowed to watch from the stands, or from the west side paddock. Any team, team member, or a family member of a team member that is found to be on the track or arena WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FOR ONE HORSE.**
- 16) **No one may mug a horse past the haze line,**
- 17) If a team drops out or does not show up, without notifying the WHR Directors James Federer (970) 355-9856 / Roy Beaver, Jr. (307) 631-5279 **PRIOR TO July 19, 2018**, that team will be responsible for the entry fee.
- 18) If entry fee is not paid, you will not be allowed to enter CFD WHR again until the fee has been paid plus a fine of \$250.00.
- 19) **There will be a 16-foot overall shank rope, 3 feet of which will be permanently attached to the halter. At the end of that 3 feet will be a 13-foot shank rope that the team will be required to take off before the rider leaves the front of the track. If the rider leaves the front of the track with the 13-rope still attached, the team will be disqualified. The mucker and shanker will be required to return the 13-foot rope to one of the judges. The team can remove the halter on the front track only. Once the rider leaves the front of the track with a halter on the horse, it must stay on the horse.**

PAY OFF: Payoff money will be split: 46% of the total purse will go to the day money; 46% of the total purse will go to the average; and 8% of the total purse will go to the short go. ALL PAYOUTS FOR DAY MONEY, SHORT GO AND AVERAGE WILL BE PAID AS FOLLOWS: 1st PLACE 40%; 2nd PLACE 30%; 3rd PLACE 20%; AND 4th PLACE 10%.

The team captain will be responsible for picking up there checks from the rodeo office, And the team captain will also be responsible for Cashing their teams check, you may not sign it over to anyone to have them cash it for you.

The top 9 teams will make it to the short go. In the event of ties, only 9 teams will be allowed to compete in the finals. All ties will be decided by a draw.

The winners of the average will be the contestants with the most money won. Three (3) trophy buckles will be awarded to the team winning the average. All winnings will be mailed to the Team Captain, 7 days after the end of the event.
