

- 8) There will be a time limit of five (5) minutes, or all places have crossed the finish line for the race. After two (2) minutes, any horse and contestant not mounted and proceeding on the track will be removed away from the gate by the pick-up men assigned to assist the WHR.
- 9) ***Contestants must be in the saddle on the horse. Riders: after you finish, dismount safely ASAP in the arena.***
- 10) In case of a tie for overall first place, a flip of the coin will determine the recipient of the buckles. If a tie exists between more than two teams, buckle winners will be determined by a draw from a hat.
- 11) ***Judges' decisions will be FINAL.***
- 12) ***PRCA dress code will be enforced.***
- 13) No companions or people without a contestant's number will be allowed in the Wild Horse Race ready area.
- 14) ***Any team members entering the arena in a state of drunkenness or under the influence of drugs or alcohol shall have his team disqualified at the discretion of the judges. No alcohol is allowed in the Wild Horse Race ready area. Violations of any of the above rules will result in disqualification and the judges' decisions will be final.***
- 15) ***If you are not up and want to watch the race: Teams will only be allowed to watch from the stands, or from the west side paddock. Any team, team member, or a family member of a team member that is found to be on the track or arena WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FOR ONE HORSE.***
- 16) ***No one may mug a horse past the haze line,***
- 17) If a team drops out or does not show up, without notifying the WHR Directors James Federer (970) 355-9856 / Roy Beaver, Jr. (307) 631-5279 ***PRIOR TO July 19, 2018***, that team will be responsible for the entry fee.
- 18) If entry fee is not paid, you will not be allowed to enter CFD WHR again until the fee has been paid plus a fine of \$250.00.
- 19) ***There will be a 16-foot overall shank rope, 3 feet of which will be permanently attached to the halter. At the end of that 3 feet will be a 13-foot shank rope that the team will be required to take off before the rider leaves the front of the track. If the rider leaves the front of the track with the 13-rope still attached, the team will be disqualified. The muggers and shanker will be required to return the 13-foot rope to one of the judges. The team can remove the halter on the front track only. Once the rider leaves the front of the track with a halter on the horse, it must stay on the horse.***

***PAY OFF:*** Payoff money will be split: 46% of the total purse will go to the day money; 46% of the total purse will go to the average; and 8% of the total purse will go to the short go. ALL PAYOUTS FOR DAY MONEY, SHORT GO AND AVERAGE WILL BE PAID AS FOLLOWS: 1<sup>st</sup> PLACE 40%; 2<sup>nd</sup> PLACE 30%; 3<sup>rd</sup> PLACE 20%; AND 4<sup>th</sup> PLACE 10%.

***The team captain will be responsible for picking up there checks from the rodeo office, And the team captain will also be responsible for Cashing their teams check, you may not sign it over to anyone to have them cash it for you.***

***The top 9 teams will make it to the short go. In the event of ties, only 11 teams will be allowed to compete in the finals. All ties will be decided by a draw.***

The winners of the average will be the contestants with the most money won. Three (3) trophy buckles will be awarded to the team winning the average. All winnings will be mailed to the Team Captain, 7 days after the end of the event.
